

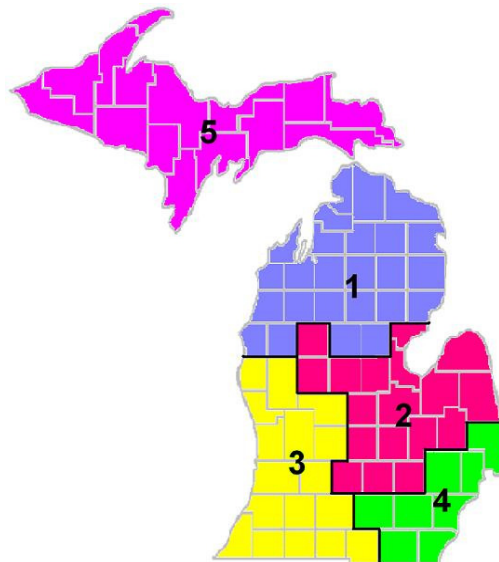
Training Opportunities

DB Central, a federally funded grant project, offers training to professionals and families on a variety of topics, as determined by needs surveys and best practices in the field. The project has training opportunities open to all people involved with children/young adults who are DeafBlind, as well as some geared for specific audiences.

Trainings may be both regional and statewide, as well as professional development opportunities (see regional training map below). Participants in DB Central trainings may be eligible to receive distance or onsite coaching. Teams selected for onsite coaching will work with project staff to develop a technical assistance agreement.

Administrators can schedule professional development opportunities for their staff by contacting the DB Central office. CEU's will be arranged upon request.
