



Everyone, ages birth through twenty-six, who has difficulty accessing visual **and** auditory information, should be registered with DB Central as long as he or she is in an educational program.

This includes:

- ☆ People who have cochlear implants and a vision loss.
- ☆ People who have documented hearing and vision losses.
- ☆ People with additional disabilities.
- ☆ People who cannot process auditory and visual information because of a severe cognitive disability.
- ☆ People who have degenerative disabilities which do or will affect their hearing and vision.

A DeafBlind label is NOT required!!

People who meet this criteria should be registered with DB Central and are eligible for FREE consultative services.

- ◆ Educational consultation
- ◆ Family Support Services
- ◆ Training on child-specific or general topics related to meeting the needs of children and young adults who are DeafBlind.
